M-Cn Do you have the updated one?

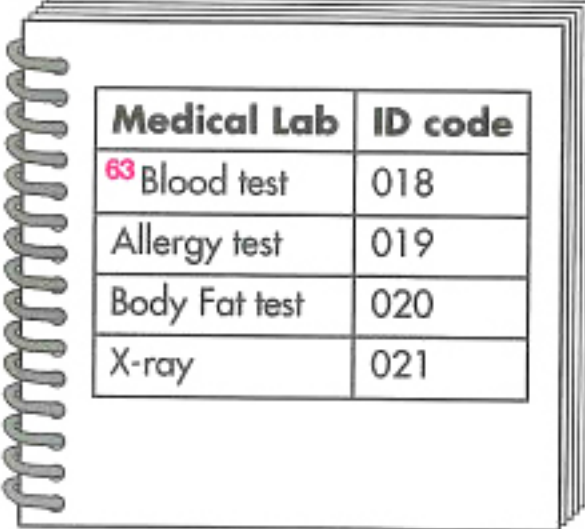
W-Am Yes, right here. **63**Which procedure is it?

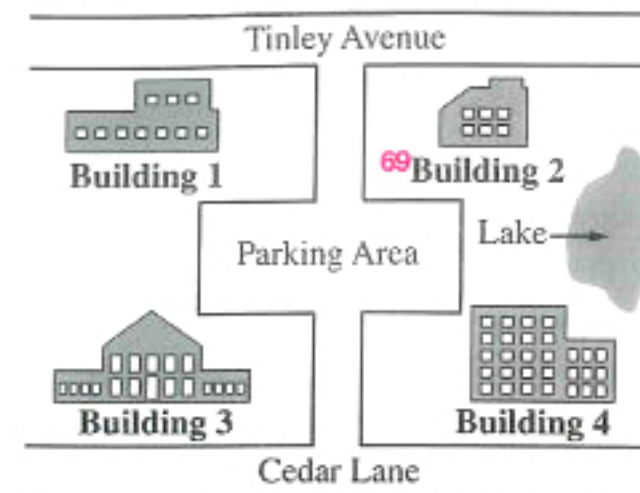
